

# GRAND FINALS - STUDENT REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

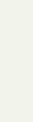
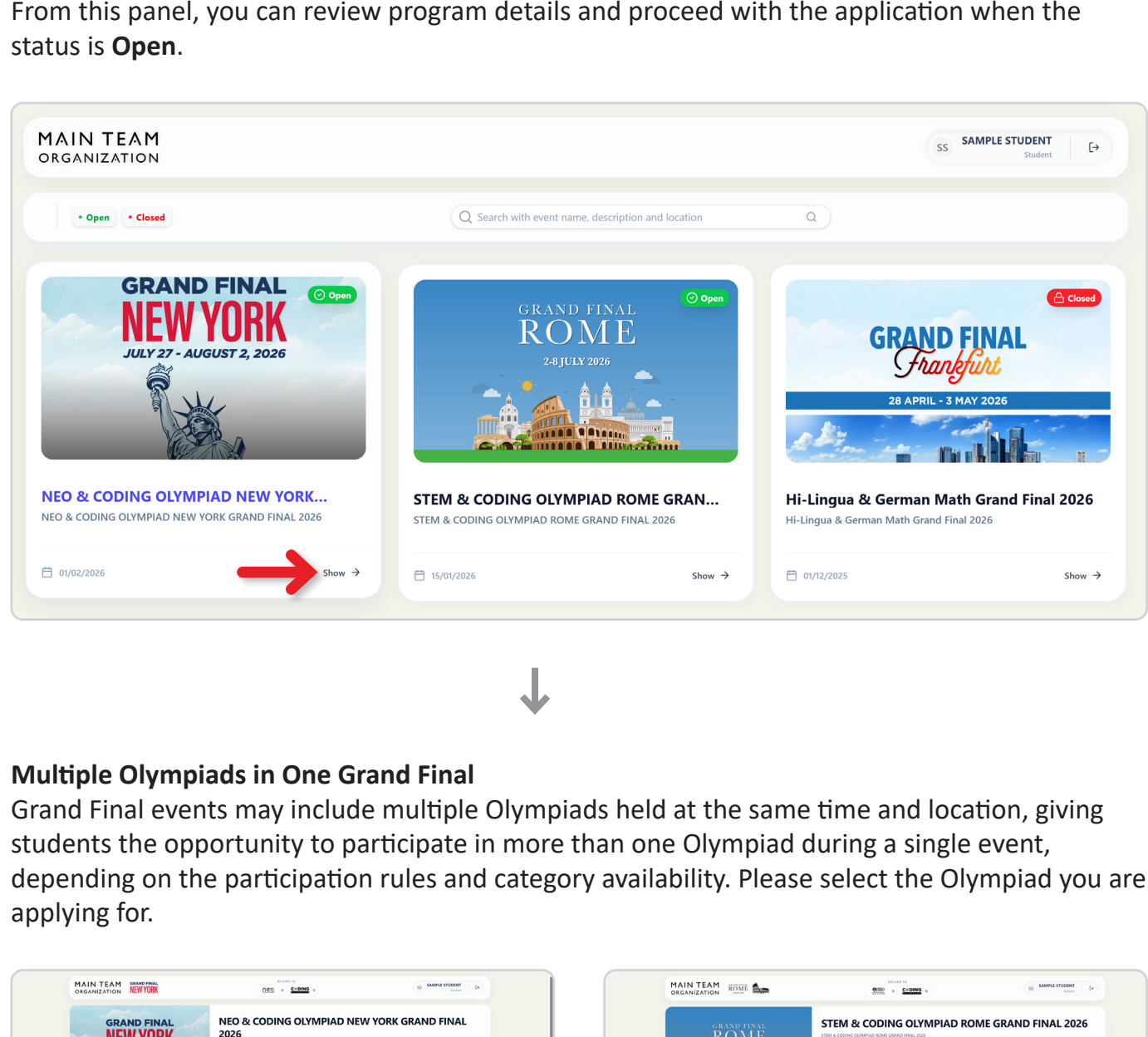
This document is a general guideline for all Grand Finals organized by MTO. The information, dates, and prices shown on the screens below are for illustrative purposes only. They may have changed and are not binding.

This guideline is intended for participants who wish to apply as Individual or Flexy participants. If you are a participant who is part of a teacher-led group, your application must be submitted by your teacher.

The activation of a Grand Final account by a participant does not guarantee participation in the Grand Final. Participation agreements will be sent to students' email addresses based on country quotas. Only after the agreement is confirmed and the required deposits are paid will participants be considered finalized.

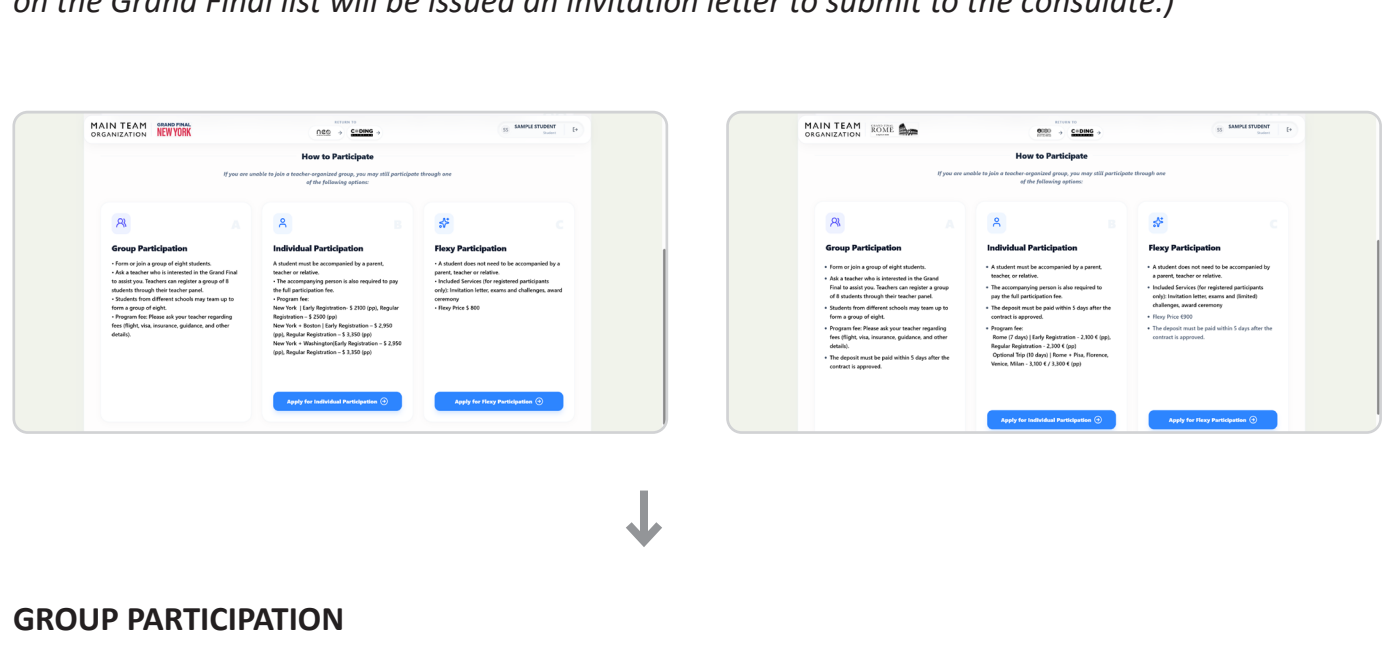


**1 Account Requirement**  
To register for any Grand Final organized by MTO, participants must have a registered and active account in the respective Olympiad dashboard. If you already have an account, please log in to your Student Panel and navigate to the "Grand Final" section in the left-side menu. (If you do not have an active MTO Olympiad account, please register for the relevant Olympiad first.)

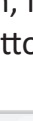
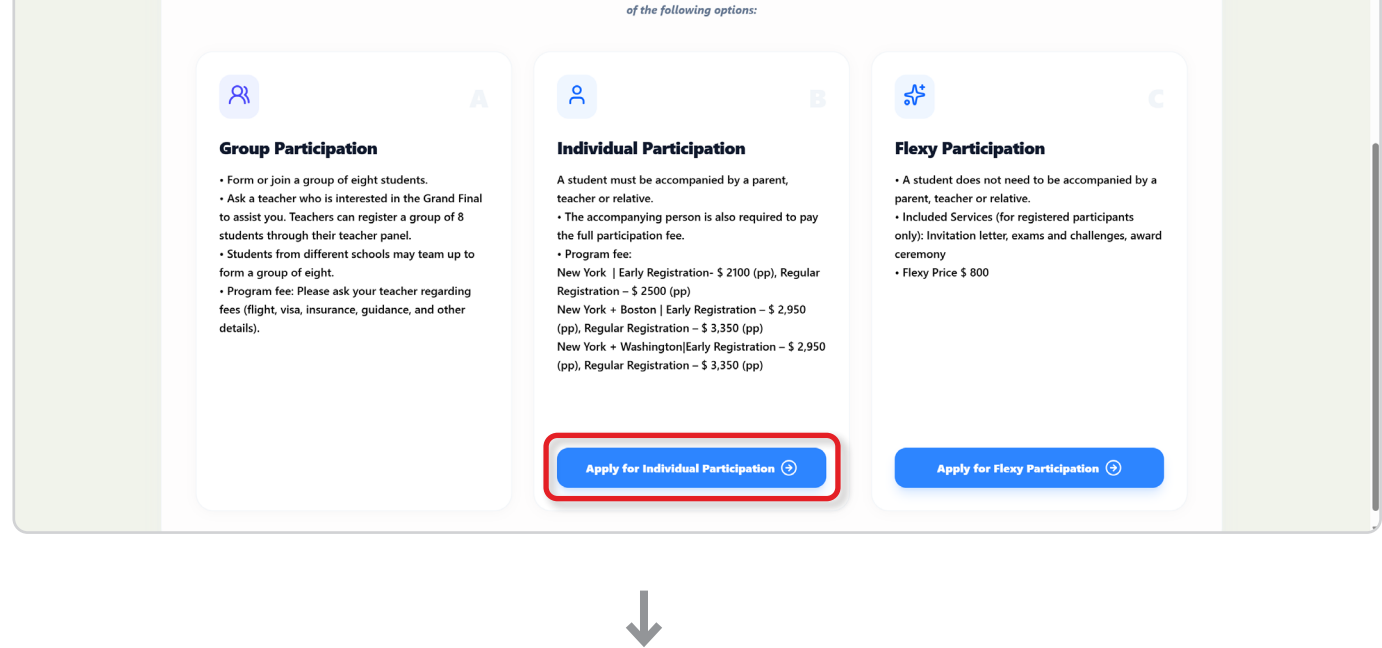


**2 Selecting the Grand Final Event**  
In the Grand Final section, you will see all available Grand Final events and their availability statuses. Each program may display one of the following statuses:

- **Open** – Applications are currently open and you may proceed with registration.
- **Pending** – The registration is not open yet and will become available once the application period begins.
- **Closed** – The application period has ended and registration is no longer available.

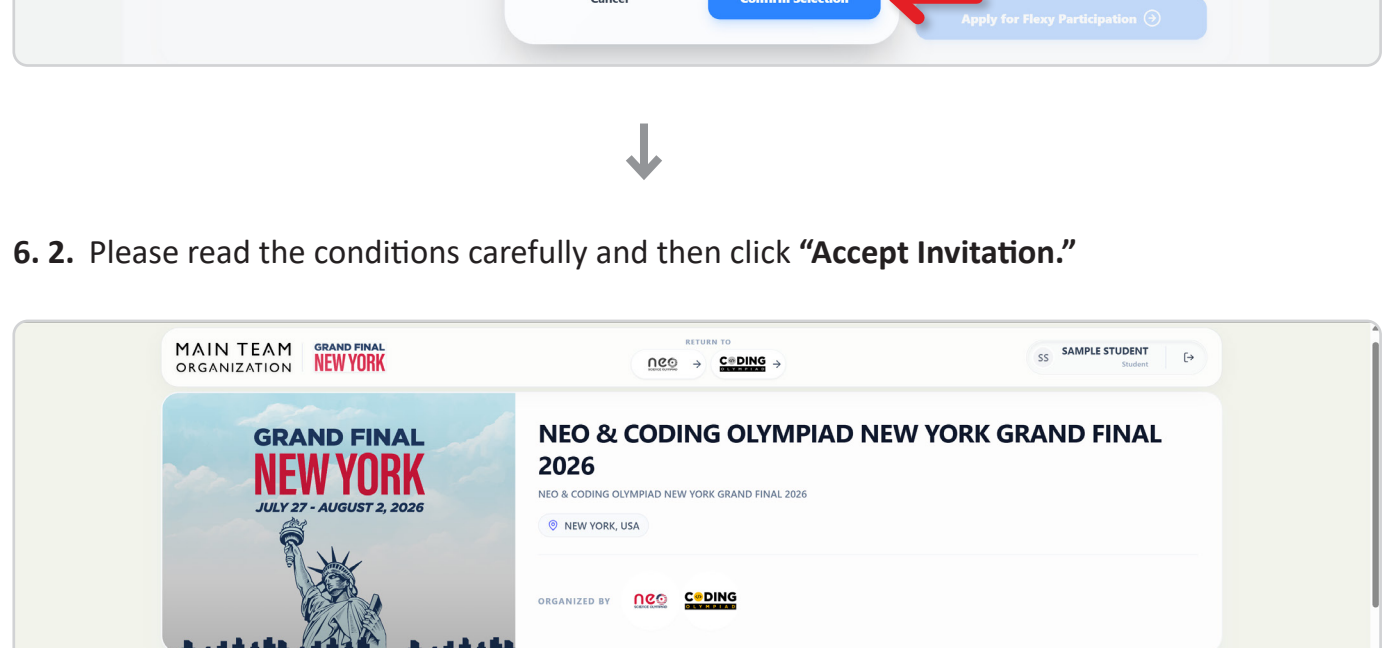


**3 Multiple Olympiads in One Grand Final**  
Grand Final events may include multiple Olympiads held at the same time and location, giving students the opportunity to participate in more than one Olympiad during a single event, depending on the participation rules and category availability. Please select the Olympiad you are applying for.



**4 Grand Final Registration Methods**  
Each Grand Final event offers 3 registration methods:

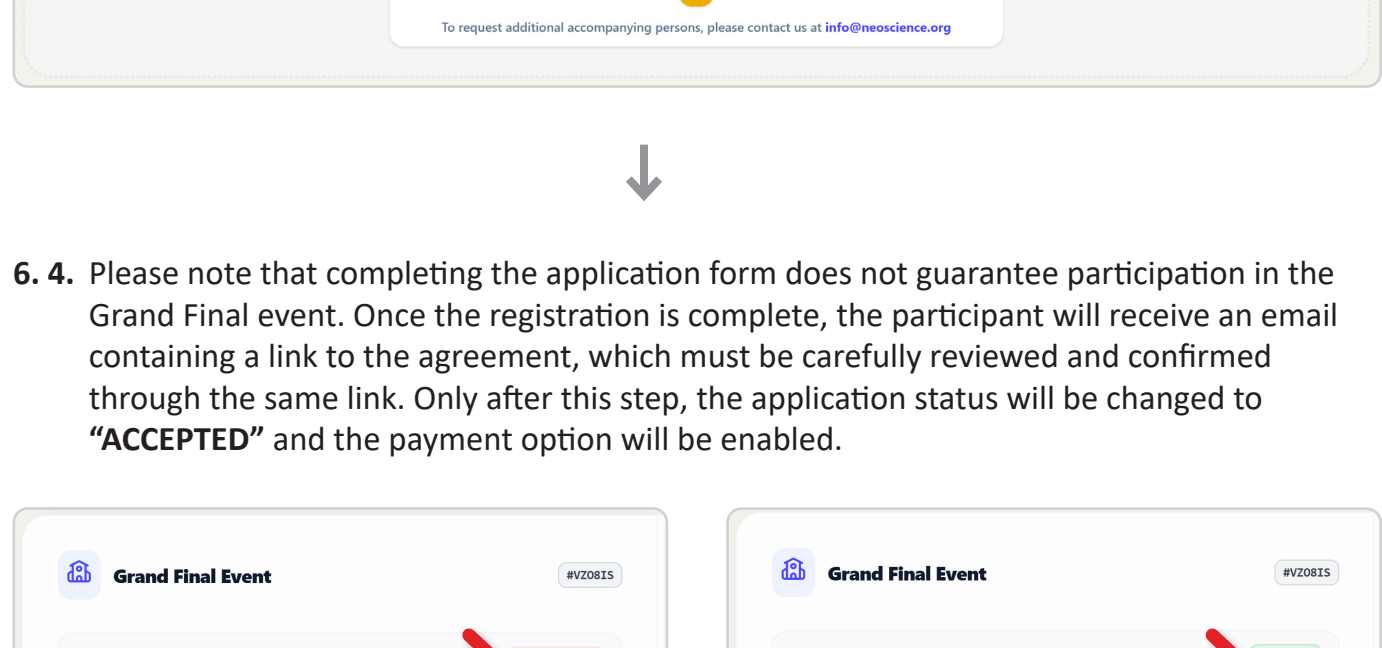
- A. **Group Participation** (for teacher/school groups)
- B. **Individual Participation** requires a student to be accompanied by at least one adult (parent, teacher, or relative), who also pays the full participation fee.
- C. **Flexy Participation** allows a student to attend without an accompanying adult, but includes limited services compared to the other two registration methods. (If an invitation is required for visa applications, these people must also be registered as Flexy Participants. Only those registered on the Grand Final list will be issued an invitation letter to submit to the consulate.)



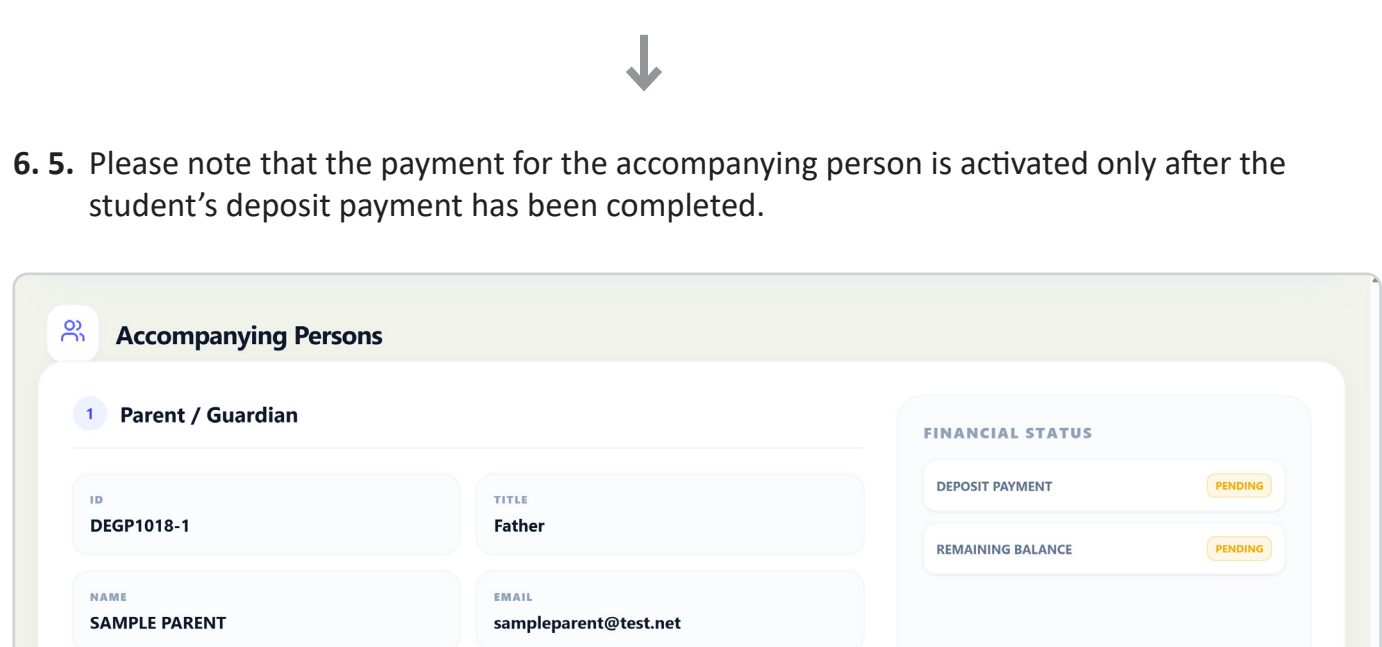
**5 GROUP PARTICIPATION**  
This registration method allows teachers to organize and manage participation in the Grand Final through their panel for teams of at least eight participants (students, parents). Students who wish to participate as a group should contact a teacher interested in the Grand Final for assistance with registration. Participants from different schools may also come together to form a team of eight.



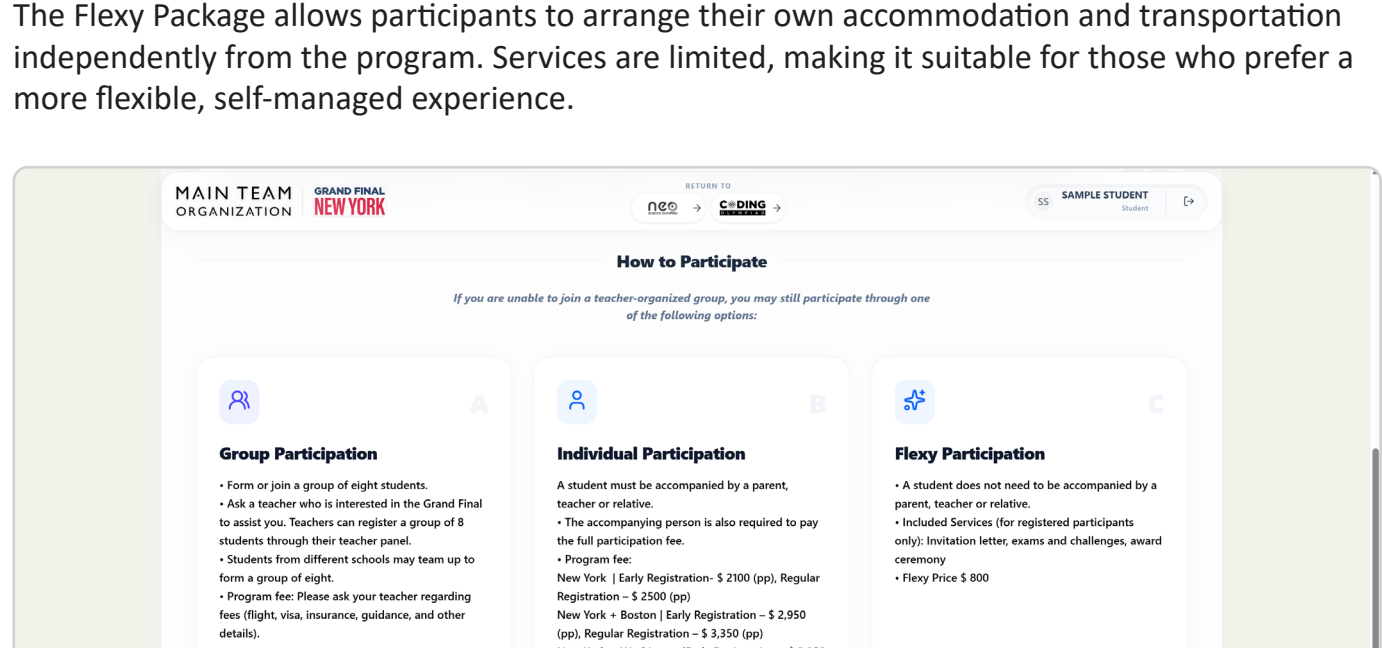
**6 INDIVIDUAL PARTICIPATION**  
Students who may not join a group from their school or country may choose this option to participate in the Grand Final. This method requires the student to be accompanied by at least one adult (parent, teacher, or relative), who must also pay the full participation fee.



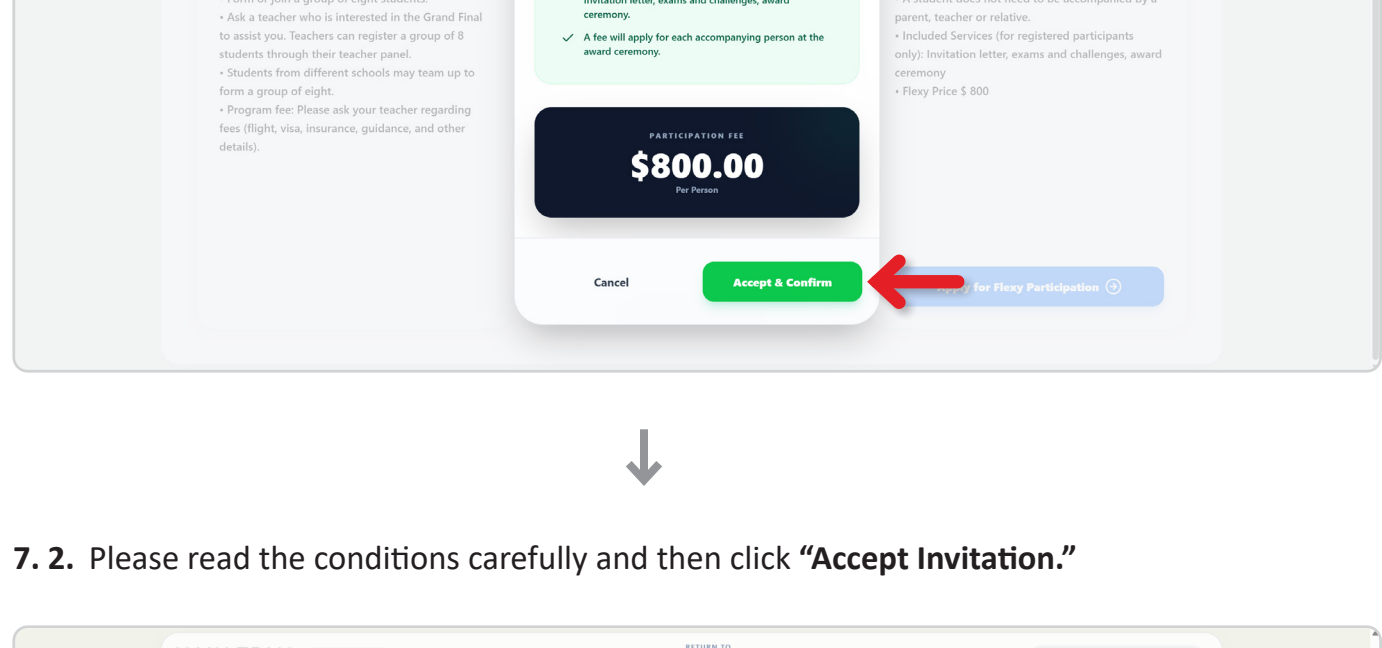
6. 1. To proceed with individual registration, first select the Grand Final program you wish to join. Then click the "Confirm Selection" button.



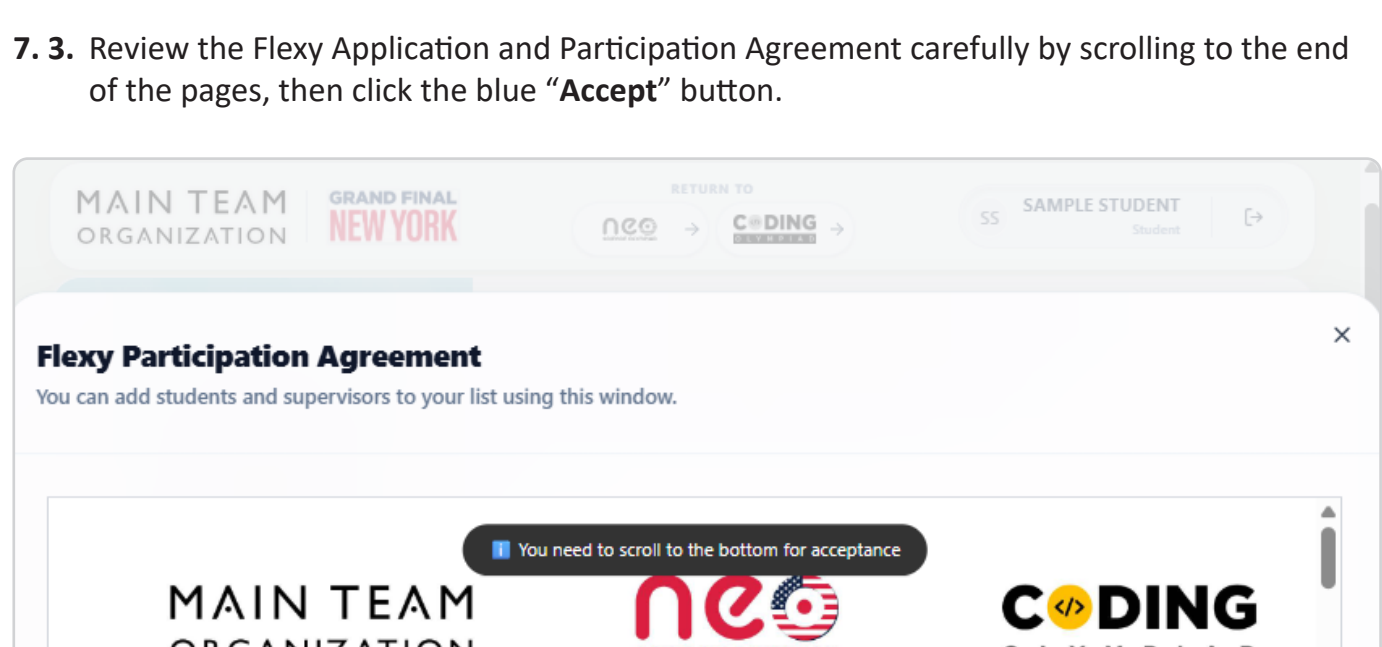
6. 2. Please read the conditions carefully and then click "Accept Invitation."



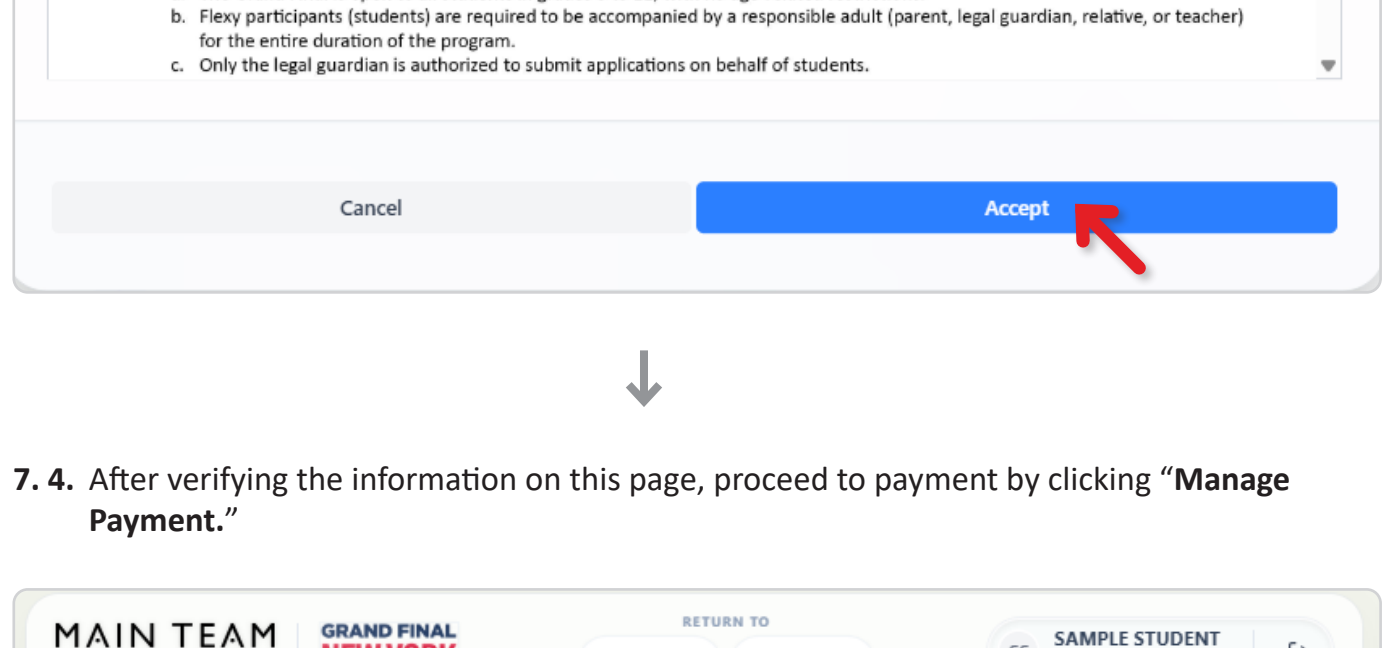
6. 3. Since individual applicants are accepted only with an accompanying person, it is required to provide the information of the accompanying person. To request a seat for an additional accompanying person, please contact us via our official email.



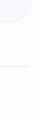
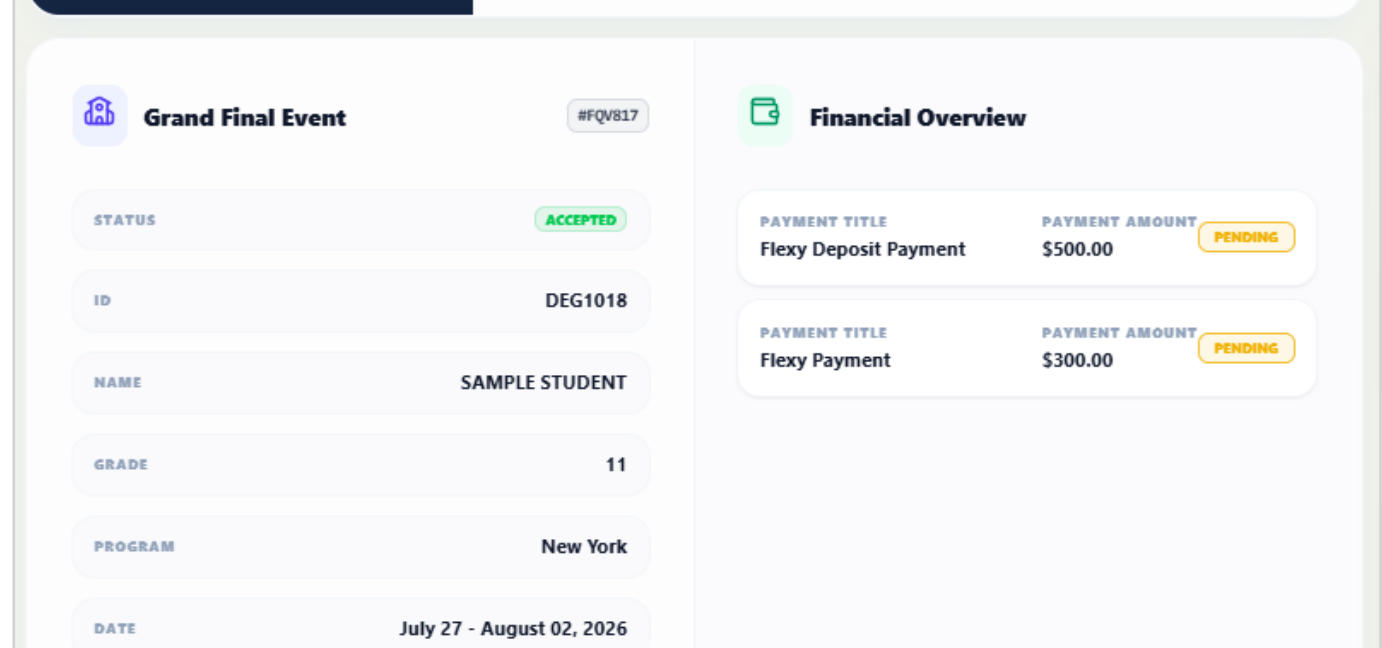
6. 4. Please note that completing the application form does not guarantee participation in the Grand Final event. Once the registration is complete, the participant will receive an email containing a link to the agreement, which must be carefully reviewed and confirmed through the same link. Only after this step, the application status will be changed to "ACCEPTED" and the payment option will be enabled.



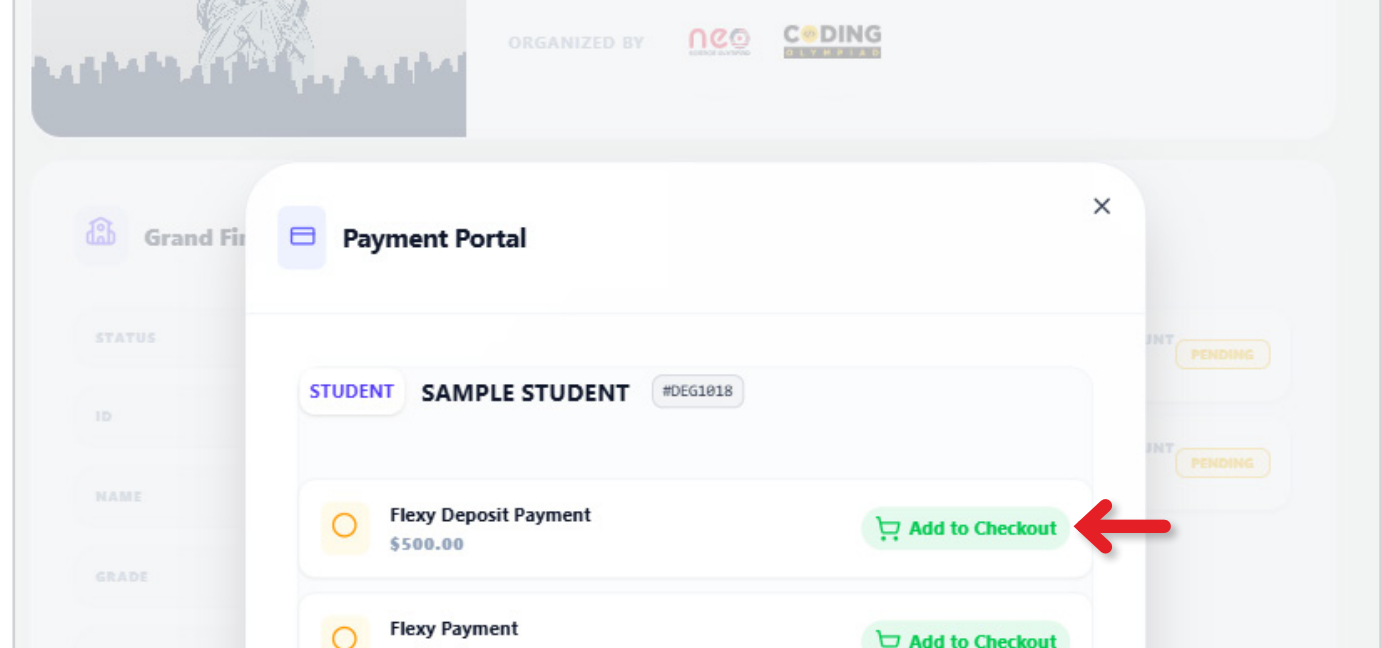
6. 5. Please note that the payment for the accompanying person is activated only after the student's deposit payment has been completed.



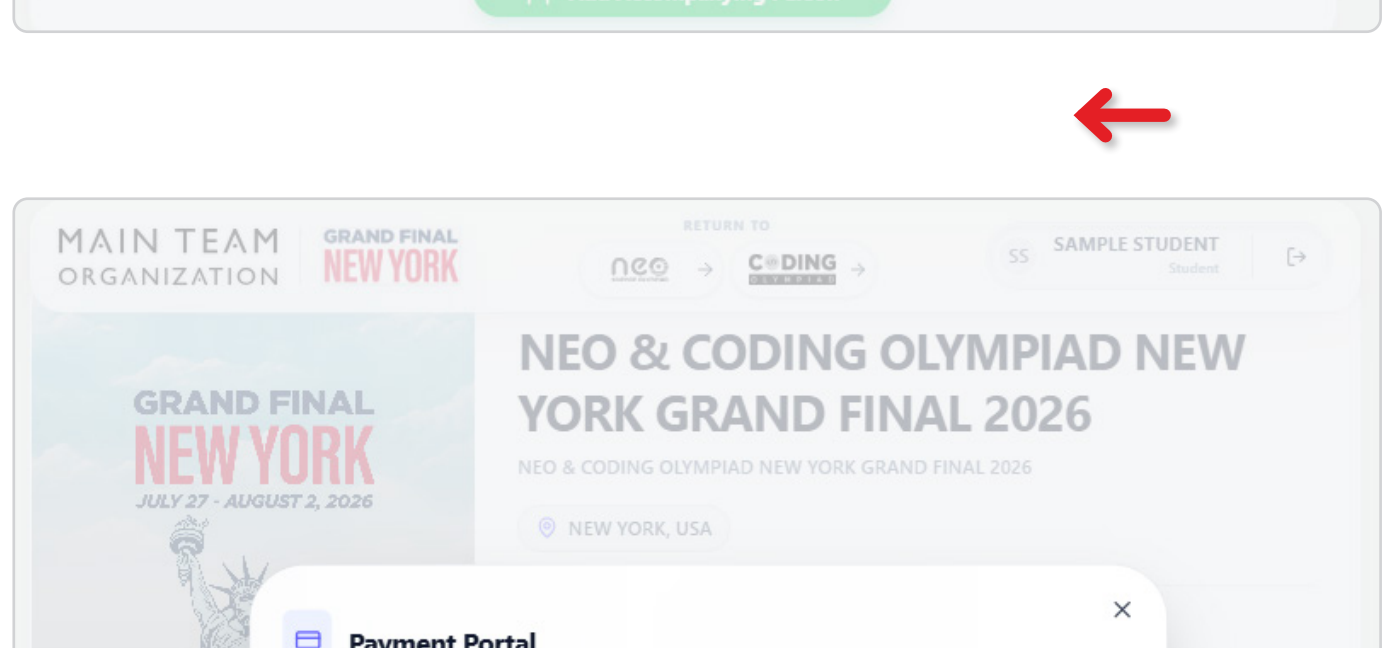
**7 FLEXY PARTICIPATION**  
The Flexy Package allows participants to arrange their own accommodation and transportation independently from the program. Services are limited, making it suitable for those who prefer a more flexible, self-managed experience.



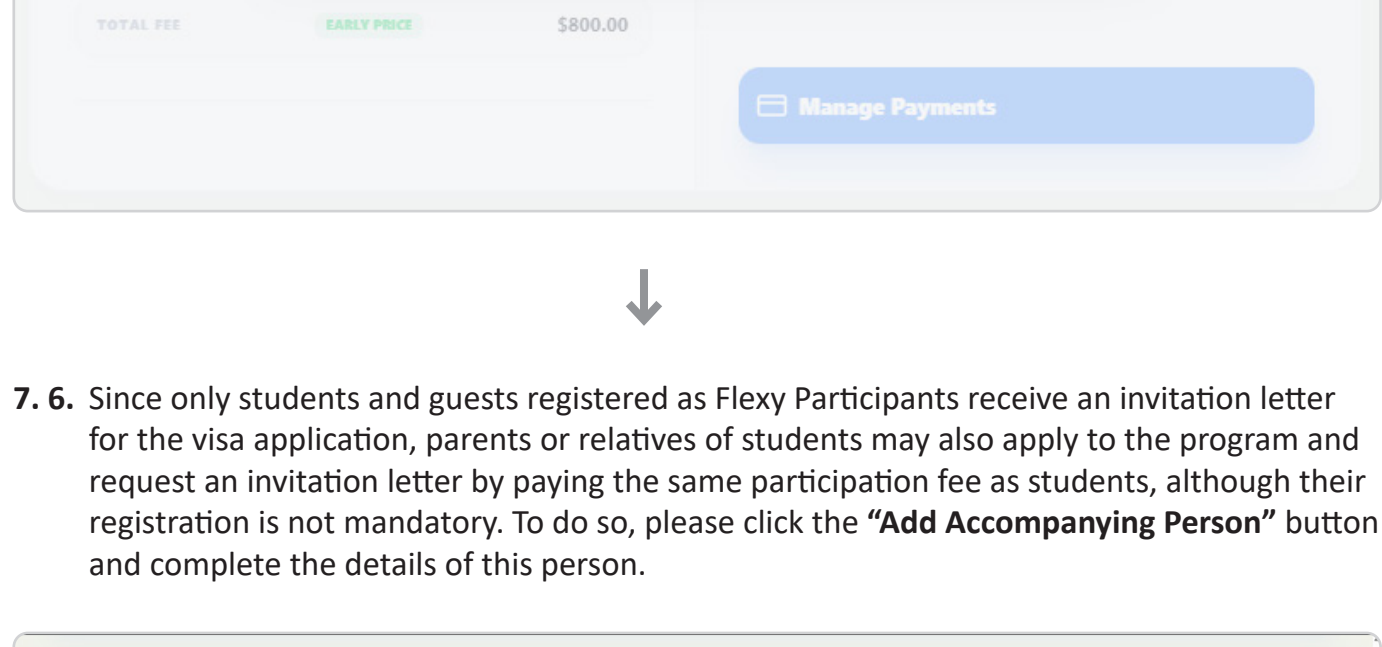
7. 1. To proceed with Flexy registration, first review the package details. Then click the "Accept and Confirm" button.



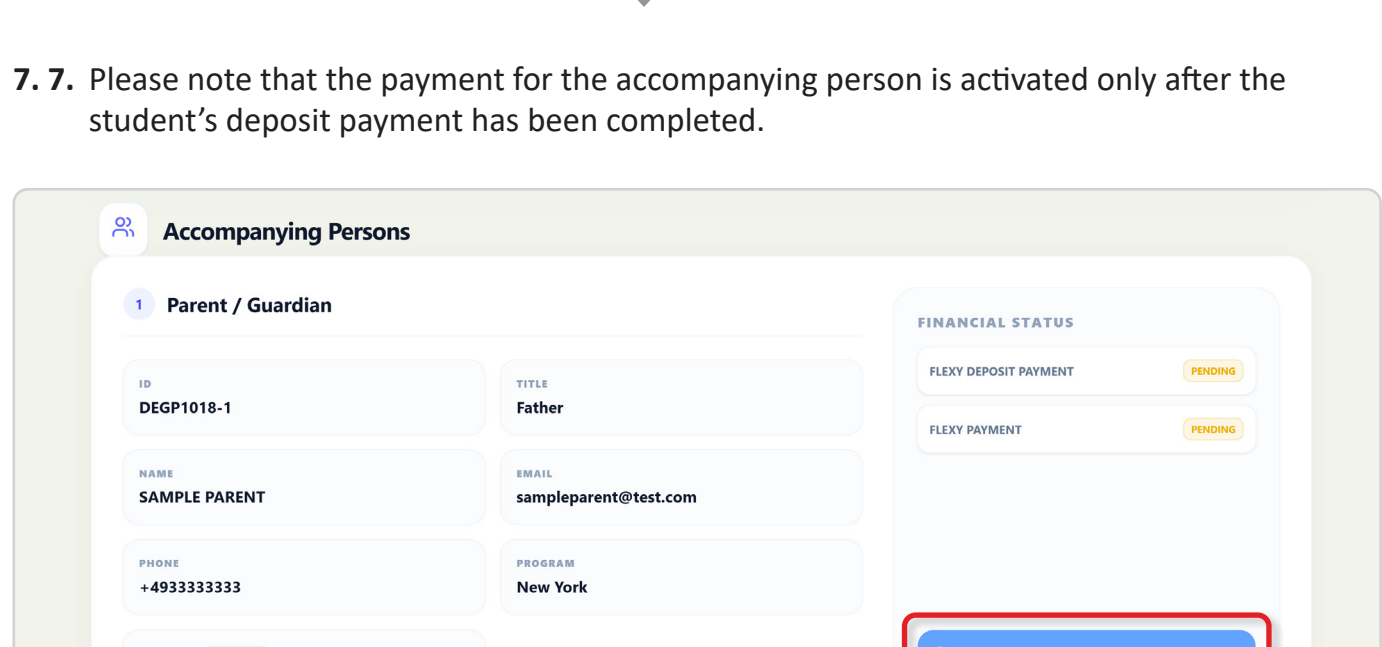
7. 2. Please read the conditions carefully and then click "Accept Invitation."



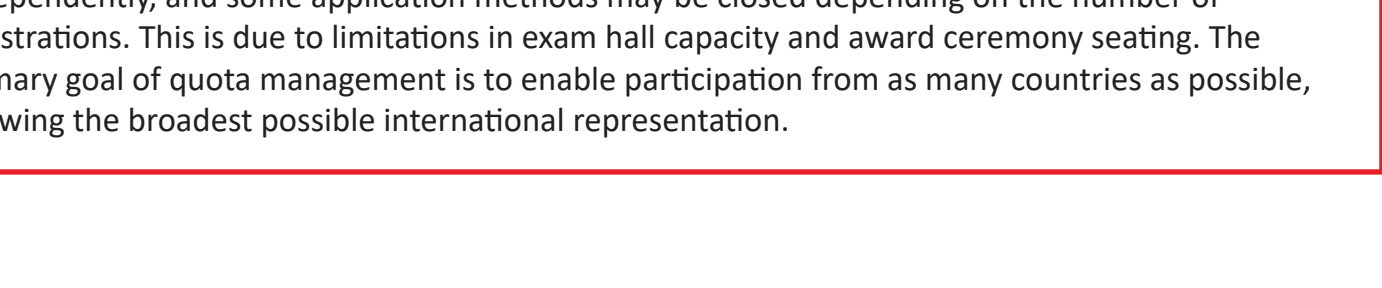
7. 3. Review the Flexy Application and Participation Agreement carefully by scrolling to the end of the pages, then click the blue "Accept" button.



7. 4. After verifying the information on this page, proceed to payment by clicking "Manage Payment."



7. 5. Please select your payment option and click "Add to Checkout" to complete a secure checkout on the payment portal.



7. 6. Since only students and guests registered as Flexy Participants receive an invitation letter for the visa application, parents or relatives of students may also apply to the program and request an invitation letter by paying the same participation fee as students, although their registration is not mandatory. To do so, please click the "Add Accompanying Person" button and complete the details of this person.



7. 7. Please note that the payment for the accompanying person is activated only after the student's deposit payment has been completed.



Flexy and individual quotas are limited and are independent of group quotas (teacher or school groups). Within each country, the quotas for the three separate registration systems operate independently, and some application methods may be closed depending on the number of registrations. This is due to limitations in exam hall capacity and award ceremony seating. The primary goal of quota management is to enable participation from as many countries as possible, allowing the broadest possible international representation.
